Hormozal Aluminium Smelter



SET LININGS INTERNATIONAL has been awarded by **FATA EPC** (division of FATA S.p.A. a FINMECCANICA Company) with the refractory installation contract of the new Anode Baking Furnace of the Hormozal Aluminium Smelter Project.

The Hormozal Aluminium Smelter is owned by IMIDRO, the Iranian Mines and Mineral Industries Development and Renovation Organization.

The smelter is located in Bandar Abbas, an industrial city located in the south of Iran, on the Arabic Gulf and the project of the new Anode Baking Furnace is scheduled to start in the summer of 2007.

The project will be implemented within the same industrial complex of the existing Almahdi Aluminium Co. smelter, whose actual primary aluminium production is 100,000 tons/year.

This expansion will increase the plant yearly capacity of 147,000 tons/year thus achieving an overall yearly production equal to 257,000 tons of aluminium.
